Requirements and Regulations

- paper must be written within the framework of the conference's objectives and themes prepared according to the terms and criteria of academic research.
- The paper should not have been previously published or presented at any previous conferences.
- The number of pages should not exceed (20) pages and not be less than (10) pages, the size (A4) of which are: margins, references, and attachments.
- After sending an e-subscription form and verifying registration in the conference, the partner will be notified under the username and password that allows him/her to send an electronic picture of the paper summary, and must be on a Microsoft Word program. Or write writer, provided that the font is written in Kurdish (Unikurd Goran) size: 14 and the font in Arabic (Traditional Arabic) size: 14 and the Times New Roman font: And the font is 12, to the margins of the page at the top and bottom (2.5 cm), to the right (1.5 cm) and to the left (2.5 cm). and Harvard's system should be considered in writing the paper.
- The languages of the conference are: Kurdish, Arabic and English.
- Summaries must not exceed (200-400) words.
- Abstracts and the papers will be reviewed.
- If a joint paper is written, at least one researcher must attend the conference.
- The researcher must attach a summary of his/her C.V. in one of the languages (Kurdish, Arabic or English)
- The approved paper will be published in a special volume of Salahaddin University's journal for Humanity Science and on the conference's website.
- Participants in the conference abroad should pay \$100, and researchers from the Kurdistan Region and inside Iraq will be paying \$50 to participate in research instead of: (Publishing research, bagging, staying and eating conference days).
